

JASON COLEMAN, PE: ENGINEER OF THE YEAR

Jason Coleman, PE, an associate project manager in the Lehigh Valley Structural Division of Pennoni Associates, Inc., will be named Engineer of the Year at the 35th Annual Engineers' Banquet organized by the Lehigh Valley Engineering Council held Friday, February 27th at the Holiday Inn Conference Center in Breinigsville, PA.

A resident of Lehigh, Mr. Coleman is a member of the Structural Engineering Institute (SEI) committee of the Lehigh Valley Chapter of the Pennsylvania Society of Engineers (LV PSPE) and serves on several committees of the International Concrete Repair Institute (ICRI). Presentations have included those for the Pennsylvania Governor's School for Engineering and Technology, the Lehigh Valley Chapter of the American Society of Civil Engineers (LV ASCE) on concrete repair and the Delaware Valley Chapter of ICRI on ground penetrating radar.

Holding professional engineering licenses in Pennsylvania, Maryland, New York and New Jersey, Mr. Coleman earned both a B.S. in Civil Engineering and a B.S. in Architectural Engineering from Drexel University. He serves on the board of directors of Drexel University's Alumni Association of the College of Engineering. A member of the Concrete Specification Institute (CSI), he holds the CSI's Document Technologist Certification and the Technician Level 1 Certification offered by the Society for Professional Rope Access concerning rope access skills to perform façade assessments.

Candidates for Engineer of the Year honors must be American citizens, work or live in the Lehigh Valley, hold professional registration, be active in professional, civic, or community organizations, and demonstrate educational achievements.
